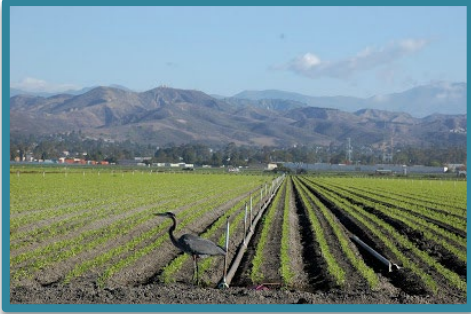

## Groundwater Sustainability Plan Periodic Evaluation Draft

Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs) are required to perform a periodic evaluation of their Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) at least once every five years. The first periodic evaluation of the Mound Basin GSP must be submitted to the State of California Department of Water Resources (DWR) by November 2026. Mound Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency (MBGSA) will be releasing the draft GSP periodic evaluation for a 45-day public comment period in early July 2026.

The GSP periodic evaluation is intended to address the following:

- Describe new information obtained since adopting the GSP.
- Describe the status of each GSP section, including any changes and whether they impact basin management.
- Explain how GSP corrective actions provided by DWR have been addressed.
- Explain whether and how actions taken by MBGSA have informed changes to basin management.
- Describe whether there is a need to change any part of the GSP that would lead to a GSP Amendment.

A key finding of the periodic evaluation is that projected future groundwater pumping from the Mound Basin is significantly less than projected in the GSP, which further supports the conclusion that the basin is already in a sustainable condition and is likely to remain so going forward.
